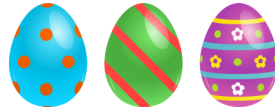

Evening Sexual Health Clinics

From April 2016 we will no longer be running the monthly evening Sexual Health Clinic.

This clinic is externally funded by East Riding Council (Public Health) and this funding has unfortunately been discontinued.

The Surgery will continue to provide this service during normal surgery hours and will aim to offer a limited number of appointments in the early morning and early evening for coil and implant procedures - please discuss with reception.

Same day and urgent appointment requests

The surgery runs a service that enables all patients who require a same day or urgent appointment to speak to the duty Doctor. The duty Doctor is often able to deal with many problems through telephone advice or signposting patients to other services. This allows us to have sufficient appointments for those that do need to be assessed. We appreciate that no service is perfect but hope you understand that we are trying our best to meet increasing demand.

Please do try self management of minor ailments before contacting the surgery. Thank you.

Online booking appointments

REMINDER - it is possible to book appointments, order prescriptions and access some information from your medical record online. For further information contact reception.

If you are already registered for Patient Access you can now download a Patient Access App for your phone which allows you to book appointments from your phone. The App is free via the App Store and Google Play.

Repeat prescriptions:

Our aim is to get these processed and ready for you to collect in two working days. However, it may help you to understand that to manage this target, your telephone voicemail message and post box contents are dealt with at 10am and again at 4pm Mon-Fri. For example if you have posted or left your request after 4pm it will be dealt with the next morning, or if after 4pm on a Friday it will be dealt with on the next working day and ready to collect two days later.

Meningitis B vaccination for children

This has been in the media recently. For parents who want their child/children to be immunised but who are not eligible for it under the NHS, this may be arranged through the practice. However at the moment there are no stocks of the vaccine available for private use. Therefore we will be keeping a record of patients who have expressed an interest in buying this vaccine for their children. Under the NHS regulations we are not permitted to administer this vaccine privately to our own patients but will be able to arrange this for you with a neighbouring practice.
